How To Make Money Part-Time Online

We try to keep all the links up to date but these guys move around pages every other day so if the link gives you a 404 page not found error) just go to root directory (like sitename.com).

OK, so you want to know some ways to make money online that actually work. I have a couple of suggestions that do produce results. And they are a good starting point for beginners since they don't require a lot of knowledge or training to jump right in and start today. None of these methods are going to make you rich in the next 24 hours, but can provide some decent part-time income on a monthly basis.

One thing that will be a huge help (and protection) is a special email address (other than your primary) to use for registering at any website for possible work opportunities. There are a lot of lions, tigers, and bears out there that want your information. Some are harmless and only allow very generic info but some are downright scoundrels and will sell you data to anyone. So using what I call a disposable email address can come in handy. I suggest Gmail since it is the safest platform (but nothing is 100% safe) and if you already have a Gmail account you can add a new email to your current account. Then you can delete the email address if necessary.

Amazon Mechanical Turk

This is one of the best kept secrets to make a few bucks online part-time. Amazon started this site back in 2005 and some people love them, and then there's some that hate them. More on that later. You can go sign up here: <https://www.mturk.com/>. But read the rest of this article first so you know what you're getting into on this method.

Amazon Mechanical Turk is a site that allows people or as they call them, "requesters" to post tasks to be completed for a specific price. Requesters can include people like small businesses, marketers, researchers, or anyone that needs some extra help on projects. These tasks are called human intelligence tasks, or HITS for short. These HITS have required activities, specific completion time, and pay amounts. Once the task is complete you submit it and get paid.

One caveat about Amazon Mechanical Turk is unfortunately only workers within the US can withdraw their earnings in cash. Outside the US, earnings can only be redeemed via Amazon gift cards. So if you live outside the US, keep that in mind.

What type of tasks? Surveys are a large area but there are also many others such as transcription of audio and videos, website and Youtube video reviews, MS Office tasks like making spreadsheets, editing documents, etc, and lots more. Sounds simple and for the most part it is simple. But this is the Internet and you still need to

pay attention, some requesters (since anyone can sign up and be a requester) are harder to deal with than others, both in instructions and payment times. You can download and use the Turkopticon toolbar. This allows you to see reviews from other Mechanical Turk workers before you decide to take on the tasks. See if a requester rejected a MTurk HIT without good reason, that's an indication of possible problems with the requestor.

Another thing to be careful about, it can take time to become familiar with the site, the type of HITS available and what HITS give you the best return on time invested. Some of the higher paying HITS require you to complete a usability test in order to be eligible to apply. Taking time to complete the tests for HITS that interest you can help to increase your earning potential.

And just because Amazon lent their name to the operation (yes, they are the owners), if you complain to them they'll tell you that they just provide the platform, it's up to the requestor to live up to the agreed upon pay in a timely manner. In other words, you're on your own.

The HITS have different pay rates because they're based on many different types of tasks and coming from different requesters. **And then there's the requester reputation that certainly impacts pay amounts and when you will receive it. Always check out the feedback of any requestor, it will save you both time and keep you out of trouble.** And double check the instructions, the devil is in the details so always pay attention to any special requirements. Some even seed the HITS with certain questions that require specific answers to check that you aren't pulling any so always pay attention and follow instructions exactly.

If you want to get a feel for the way Mechanical Turk works, there are forums like MturkGrind and Mturkforums with a lot of helpful people. There are Turk Nation forums too but I've heard nothing but bad reviews about them and the people involved so I don't recommend them.

The first question I always get is how much money can you make? There are people out there that write books on the subject and say you can make XXX amount or a fulltime living. My take is it's all over the map, just like anything else. The HITS pay can start as low as .05 cents and go up to \$15. The more involved the task, the higher the rate. Will it replace a real job? That's dependent on you and your skills. But realistically from the feedback I get is that you can make some good part-time money, maybe in the \$150 to \$200 range per month after you learn the ropes (which HITS and requesters are the best for you and provide a more involved service). But I'll qualify that with you need to find some good requesters and also check the website frequently since all the good HITS (the ones that pay well and are easy to complete in the time period) are snapped up very quickly.

So in summary, here are the good points and not so good points about Amazon Mechanical Turk.

Pros

Flexibility Do as much or as little work as you have time (any time - not just 9-5).

Get paid in cash. If you are U.S. based, you get paid in cash and there are no minimums to hit before you can cash out. People from other locations may only be able to get gift cards, no cash.

Work That Anyone Can Do. You can get steady work if you find some good requestors that are very active and pay quickly. You don't need special skills for most HITS. But I would highly recommend brushing up on your typing skills, almost all HITS involve some data entry. And watch the type of work that is often offered and learn how to complete these tasks if you don't already have the skills. One of the best tricks to get more and higher paying HITS is to look at the most frequent and highest paying offered and become an expert.

Cons

Dependability. There's only so many opportunities available each day. You have to check often and jump on the HITS quickly due to so many people on the website. And your profile and experience (some HITS require you to have XXX amount of completed HITS) are necessary to qualify for some of the best paying HITS.

You Need To Check Out Any Requestor. Even if the HITS pay well, that doesn't mean you get paid. Due diligence is necessary to find good and reliable requestors.

It's part-time. While the extra income is great, you won't get rich doing this. And you need to be active and check the available HITS often.

The bottom line is that many people make great part-time income from Amazon Mechanical Turk and you can too. But it's not for everyone, you need to try it out and see how it fits you and your situation. Some effort is necessary to learn the ropes and get familiar with the website, and you need to follow the instructions (that means simply that you do need to read the instructions).

Survey Sites

There are many Survey websites out there but I'm only going to recommend one, [Swagbucks.com](https://www.swagbucks.com). The reason is that this website pays in cash or gift cards from big time players like Amazon, PayPal, Walmart, and etc. But beware that they do use a point/rewards system, it's called Swagbucks and it works out to about 100 SB equals \$1.00. The website is easy to navigate, protects your information, and offer other ways to earn points. Profiles and experience are really important. Many surveys are directed at specific types of demographics (people with children, college graduates, interest in hobbies, etc.). So make sure you fill out all the requested information and you'll have a better chance at getting more surveys.

Some of the less than good survey websites will sell your personal information, only give you rewards, prizes, or discounts on other products and take weeks to collect. This may work for some but I don't recommend them since security these days is always important and waiting for payment is not a good thing. I would be very careful joining any of these survey websites since many are way to lose with your private information and have long wait times for any type of compensation.

SwagBucks is one of the best (if not the best) but it's got the same problems of any survey website. It's not going to provide you with enough work (surveys or other tasks) to make a lot of money. In fact I just saw some stats that most users only average about 10 surveys a month. And many of their surveys only pay 100 SB (\$1) so even with doing some other tasks you won't make much. And like many survey websites you can pick a survey and after about 10 questions if you don't qualify they tell you to stop.

But it's worth checking out since they are very legit and you may find a niche within the surveys and other tasks that can produce some steady revenue.

Website Tester or Website Evaluator

The good news is that this type of work pays better than Surveys and other tasks above. The bad news is that once again there are far more testers than websites to test. But the pay is a lot better, starting around \$3 and often in the \$10-\$12 range per test or evaluation. But there is a much more strenuous requirements for these higher paying tasks.

Equipment

You need to own a computer and microphone

You need a fast internet connection (broadband)

Personal

- You'll need to fill out a form with demographic information (your gender, computer experience, age, etc)
- You have to be at least 18 years old
- You have to do a sample test of common types of evaluations

Most of the evaluations you will do involve recording your comments and activities with a screencast software that records as you evaluate. Hence the microphone and fast connection. Most supply the software for recording and it's pretty simple to operate.

The testing can be simple, where you look at specific items (outlined in instructions) and make comments on ease of use, navigation, and even content. Demographics rule on your selection as an evaluator, so try and fill the information as in depth as possible.

And you do get rated by the client so this is a little more involved than just a survey. Most pay directly through PayPal so obviously you will need a PayPal account too. Payment is much faster than survey sites, weekly for most.

Summary

All of these websites offer a chance to make a few extra bucks every week. The downside is that they just don't have enough work to do for the number of people registered. Never the less, it's a great starting point for many beginners. And if you combine all three and really hustle you can make an extra few hundred bucks. The big advantage is the flexibility, working from home or anywhere, and you can start today.

Gift Cards

One extra way that you can stretch your current income is by taking advantage of the current craze on gift cards. I'm sure you've seen them in many stores, a whole shelf of name brand prepaid debit cards. If you really watch the sales (especially around the holidays) you can pick up a \$100 gift card for less than the value. Promotions can go up to 15% off (\$100 card costs \$85). If you don't want to wait for a sale, go to eBay and search for gift cards. There are generic Master Card and Visa cards available too and you can use those anywhere. Many people get them as gifts and would rather have cash. So they offer these unwanted cards for sale at a good discount off face value. Since you'll be going through eBay and PayPal you are somewhat protected so the risk is low. Worth a look, my niece is a master at this and probably saves at least \$200 on Christmas gifts.

How To Make Money Part-Time Offline

Mystery Shoppers

In this section we're going to introduce you to another way to find some good part-time income. I don't know if you've heard about this type of work but let me introduce you to the Mystery Shopper opportunities. These opportunities do require you to physically go to retail stores so they aren't technically online but that's how you get the gig and report results.

It's kind of like doing a survey in real time at a particular type of business and providing feedback on how well they treat their customers. Some companies have multiple types of businesses they work with and some specialize in special niches. A good example is you would be tasked with visiting a retail store and write a report on the first impressions, customer service, and ease of finding whatever product they sell. Depending on the type of business, it might be a restaurant, Health Spa, Amusement Park, Car Dealership, and many other types of businesses.

This type of onsite review business has been around for a long time is used by both large national companies and local companies too. The good news is you often get a free meal, day at the Spa or Amusement Park, and other side benefits from doing this kind of work. But like the surveys, there are far more people than gigs and so it will probably not replace a full time job. But you can make some reasonable part-time income and often have fun doing it.

How much can you make? Well it depends on the company or assignment as usual. It can be as little as \$20 and any expenses or as much as \$65 and expenses for the more involved (more time) tasks. But a lot people like this type of work once they try it so it's not just about the money.

There is one huge downside though, the scammers are hard at work in this type of offering. You really have to be careful and do your research on any company you find in this type of work. Here's three things to watch out for since they are often used in a typical scam:

- ***Never agree to cash a check and send money back, this can have several slants so be aware.***
- ***Don't pay to get lists of Mystery Shopping jobs or companies.***
- ***Don't pay for training, made up certificates, or website access to find jobs***

All of these methods are huge red flags that the company is probably not legit. They tell a good story and make it seem like the world will be yours if you just pay for this secret information. No, there are few secrets if any, and you don't need any special training.

We have a list of legit websites below that offer real opportunities for this type of work.

You want to have a PayPal account since most pay direct to your PayPal account. Some will offer to pay by

check but all the does is slow down your payments so I'd go with PayPal if possible. And on any given day some of these companies pay faster than others. Normally within a week or two of assignment completion. But each one may be different so always keep an eye on them.

Most Mystery Shopper companies evaluate Mystery Shoppers for their integrity, writing skills, and attention to detail. So it is important to be as diligent as possible and follow instructions. There rarely is any special requirements but you do need to exhibit good communication skills and be prompt with your reports. And if you aren't able to go onsite for whatever reason, this may limit your opportunities.

In order to give you a little jump start in finding some real and legit opportunities we've got a list of six companies that we know to be on the up and up. But we also want you to always pay attention to the details and never sign anything without doing due diligence. Companies change, are bought out, and so forth.



How To Make Money Part-Time With Phone Apps

This is a pretty interesting group of applications that you can make some part-time income with and have some fun too. There are a couple issues you do want to pay attention to that come along with the money and fun. Several apps will pay you to not necessarily spy but observe places you go and therefore leave your privacy at risk. Since they want to track you as you visit local businesses, take pictures from your phone, and generally know where you go. Just keep in mind that when you use these apps you are exposing yourself indirectly. So always pay attention and be careful.

Another factor with some of these applications is they offer points (they use many cute names) and often called online currency that can be used to buy items at their individual stores or receive a gift card from major retailers. Some may offer cash via PayPal or Venmo or universal gift cards.

OK, so now that we've reminded you of privacy, personal safety, and payment methods let's see what we have to offer.

Nicequest

This is a survey company that allows you to take surveys (small and quick usually) on your phone. They will send you surveys that fit your profile. Pretty straightforward and they use "shells" that relate to their online stores.

Nielsen

This I'm sure you have heard of the Nielsen ratings company. Well, they have an app that you can install on your phone that provides them information. It's just taking non-personal data on how you use your phone. Not a lot of bucks but an extra \$50 per year.

SlidJoy

If you're not allergic to seeing ads on your phone (I am, they drive me nuts but many don't care) this is a good way to make an extra \$60 a year. This is only for US Android users and you can get paid in cash or gift cards to major retailers. Just remember every time you use your phone you get to watch some ads.

VipVoice

If you want to become a member of a focus group (online research panel) and have a webcam, sign up for VipVoice. You can make up to \$20 a month that is paid with PayPal or a check. The focus Groups can be about anything and both large and small. Some are quite interesting so there could be fun for some.

Surrogate Juror

I'm sure you've seen a movie or television show where the attorney's create a make believe jury to test ever thing about an upcoming trial. You can sign up for Surrogate or Mock Jury service, some are strictly online and some you actually go to somewhere in your community. The two are quite different, the online is usually where you view all the evidence and listen to each side of the story. It's much easier on you since you do it from home and often pays better (up to \$60 for an hour). Whereas the ones that you actually go someplace and interact with other mock jurors and can be an all day schedule. You get paid more (around \$150 per day) but you spend a lot more time so you are actually making less per hour compared to the online versions.

Most Mock Jury requirements have to do with your location, and that you are not a felon and in good standing US citizen over 18. Of course depending on the case and the attorneys there could be very specific requirements that are different in each case.

The online versions are Ejury (quick and easy but only \$5-10) and Online Verdict (up to \$60). The in person Mock jury opportunities are with National Research Staffing (up to \$150 per day), and SignupDirect.com (around \$100 per day).

Ibatta Receipt Pictures

Just as it says above, you can get money for taking pictures of your receipts. Here's how it works. Ibatta has cash back offers on their website that you can use whenever there is something of interest to you. Once you purchase something you just take a photo of your receipt and get anywhere from .02% to \$3 back for the purchase. Depending on where you live, you may have more or less offers but amny are from national companies so you have a good shot at finding an appropriate offer. Once you aquire \$20 you can request a payment via PayPal or Venmo. That's it, simple and easy for anyone.
